## Top tips

- The discussion works best in small groups in a relaxed and informal setting. We'd recommend a group of six to ten people. You can download personal invitations at kitchentable.org.uk/inspire
- Inspire can be run in one session or two. If you have a chatty group
  then we'd suggest you spread the material over two sessions. A good
  break point is after looking at the four elements that build faith on
  page nine of the leader's guide.
- 3. Prepare for your evening using the leader's guide. The questions and format begin on page six. If you'd like some more tips, download the 'Guide to running a small group' from kitchentable.org.uk/inspire
- 4. Don't expect to get through all the discussion cards! Have a look through and pull out four or five you think would be good starter questions, and use the others in another session, when you meet up for coffee, or even to spark discussion in an online group.
