

GAMES AND ACTIVITIES

1 Host a gingerbread house competition

Work together in groups to build and decorate gingerbread houses. Get as creative as you want and ask a few people to judge the competition.

Top tip: Encourage people to bring their own decorations and little bags to take some gingerbread home at the end.

2 The collective winter story!

Give each group a piece of paper. The first person writes one sentence along the top of the page to start a winter story and then folds the paper over to cover their words. The next person writes a sentence below this and folds the paper to cover their words. You continue around the group, writing sentences and folding the paper as you go. When everyone has had a go ask someone to unfold the paper and read the story out to the group. You could even swap stories with another group to make it more fun! Your paper will start to look like a concertina fan, as you write your story.

Top tip: Make sure there's enough room on the paper for everyone to write a line of the story.

3 Blocks and 'Doh'

Have a selection of Play-Doh and building blocks available for younger children to play with. You could encourage them to create their favourite story from the Bible.

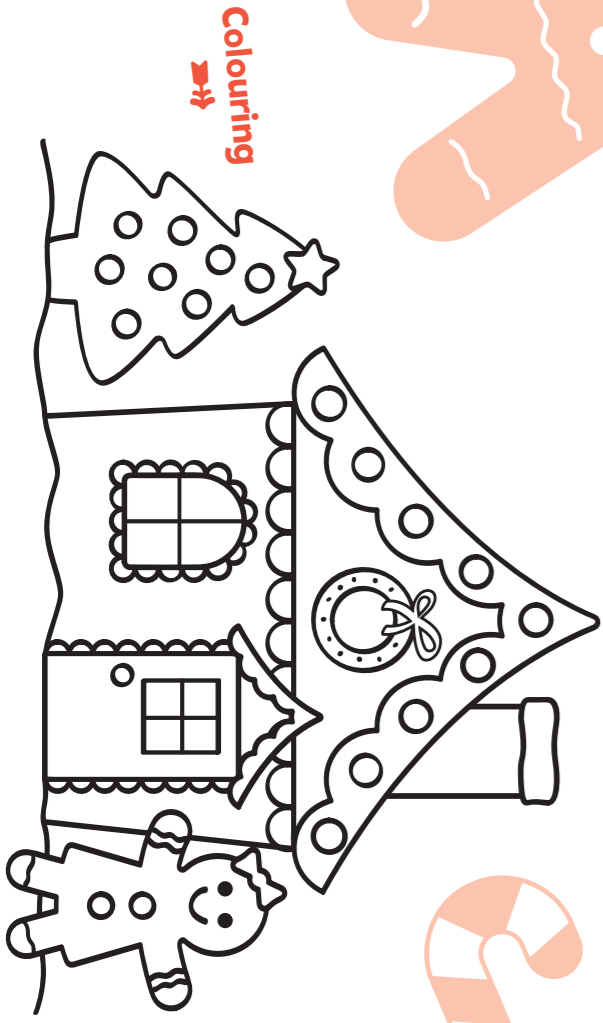
4 Have a paper snowball challenge!

Scrumple up lots of paper (this could be a great way to recycle!) and give each team an equal amount of snowballs.

Set the 'game zone', decide on the rules, and set the timer. The team with the least amount of snowballs in their zone at the end of the time wins.

If you've got multiple teams, you could do a mini snowball tournament!

Top tip: Remember to recycle your paper when you're finished.
