## Parent group discussion questions

- 1. What intergenerational relationships do your children already have? This could be with older relatives, teenagers in the church, youth leaders or other influencers.
- 2. Who could you ask to be a positive influence on your children? How could you facilitate those relationships? What are the challenges to doing this?
- 3. Do you find it difficult to really listen to your children?
- 4. How could you actively listen more to what they are actually asking?
- 5. Can you identify any times where the questions your children ask have been more deeply rooted in questions of purpose, identity or belonging?
- 6. How comfortable are you with your children's worldview or opinions being different to yours?
- 7. How can you love them well even when they think differently to you?
- 8. What do you think about the three words Kara suggests help us give Jesus-centred answers to big questions?
