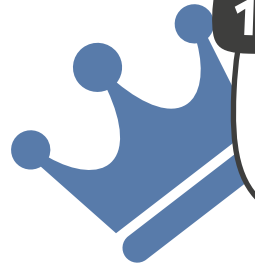

2 Build a palace fit for a king

Using Play-Doh or building blocks, work together to build a palace. A great activity for younger children!

3 Play heads or tails

Get everyone to stand up and choose whether to put their hands on their heads or their 'tails'. Toss a coin, whichever side of the coin it lands on represents the winners, they stay standing and go through to the next round. Keep tossing a coin until you have one person left standing. They're the ultimate winner!

4 Make a time capsule

This is a great way of recording significant moments for future generations to discover. You may want to make a digital version with photos, videos and stories from your guests. If you make a physical one, ask people to bring things to place in the capsule, e.g. newspaper articles, photographs, an invitation, letters from guests.
